1 Chronicles 3:1-17 (my translation for Baker)

3:1 These were the sons of David who were born to him in Hebron: the firstborn (1) Amnon, by Ahinoam the Jezreelite; the second (2), Daniel by Abigail the Carmelite; the third (3) Absalom son of Maacah, daughter of Talmai king of Geshur; the fourth (4) was Adonijah son of Haggith; ³the fifth (5), Shephatiah by Abital; the sixth (6) Ithream by Eglah his wife. ⁴Six were born to him in Hebron and he reigned there seven years and six months.

He reigned thirty-three years in Jerusalem. ⁵These were born to him in Jerusalem: Shimea, Shobab, Nathan, and Solomon, four by <u>Bath-shua</u> (2:3) daughter of Ammiel. ⁶And Ibhar, Elishama, Eliphelet, ⁷Nogah, Nepheg, Japhia, ⁸Elishama, Eliada, Eliphelet, nine. ⁹All *these were* the sons of David, besides the sons of the <u>concubines</u>; and <u>Tamar</u> (2:4) was their <u>sister</u>.
